Home Life Hosts Refuge Ranch Christmas Party

The Home Life Committee is again sponsoring a Christmas Party for the residents of the Refuge Ranch on Tuesday, December 17th, from 1 to 3 p.m. at the Clubhouse.

The Ranch is a long-term residential program for young women to help them reach their recovery goals from drugs and alcohol while experiencing a new life despite their inability to pay for the program. Before entering the program, many of these women were homeless, jobless and lost their families. Through the Christmas party, Stuart Woman's Club members can share individual gifts, hugs, love and fellowship as we spend the afternoon together.

Each resident receives two gifts of clothing, as well as numerous other gifts from the generous support of club members. Gift suggestions are makeup, jewelry, hair accessories, perfume... anything a young woman would love! If you adopt a resident, you are given a shirt size. Oddly enough, when the resident opens the gifts they are so grateful and love the color and style that has been selected for them.

The party opens with light refreshments followed by a brief introduction of the Ranch by Mitchell Dobrow, Director, and several testimonies from residents. Then the fun begins....gift time. Individual gifts are distributed to all the residents, and then each woman comes to the gift table to select another gift. This keeps going until all the gifts are gone. If there is an odd number of gifts, the remainder are sent with Mitchell.


